

Dissemination activity report debate 12.05.2016. ASD

Association of Students with Disabilities, Belgrade, Serbia (ASD) on day 12th of May participated in debate on theme „Process of studying and acquisition professional competences of students with disabilities“.

Debate was held at Faculty of Philosophy in organisation of ASD with support of „Association students of psychology“. This event has gathered more than 50 students from Faculty of philosophy, Faculty of special education and rehabilitation, Faculty of law and Faculty of organisational science. During the debate our coordinator Milan Jankovic presented a project “Trans2work” main goals of project and main results which are expected. As a lecturer, he put specific focus on research and open-questions from “Trans2Work” questionnaire: *“Has your faculty enabled/facilitated you to acquire knowledge and do practical work or other activities that may help you find a job? “Do you think that your studies will increase your skills to find a job and become competitive on the labour market?”; “Do you need additional training in order to find a job?”*. On that way he encouraged large discussion between students. The students were active participants in debate, they asked questions and gave comments, and as the result of debate they give recommendations and ideas which refers in improvement status of students with disabilities. One of them is that is important to develop permanently peer assistance. In that way students showed that they are interested to take part in training for peer assistance. The second one, comes as a result of presented “Trans2Work” - an initiative of students from all four faculties that, with the support of ASD, construct the instrument to examined the quality studies of students with disabilities.

In conclusion we can say that the debate was really productive and exceeded our expectations in positive way. In attachment you can find the pictures and see the part of atmosphere at the debate.
