Introduction

Objectives of the dissemination activities:

- To inform the general public and academia about the *Trans2Work* objectives and results so far;
- To specify the details of the SwDs participation in mobility programme of the project;
- To register SwDs on web-based database;
- To SwDs get acquainted with their duties and tasks during and after mobility.

Short description of activities

This round table was organized at the University of East Sarajevo at the premises of the rector's office on Monday, October 30, 2017. It was attended by students with disabilities from different faculties of the University of East Sarajevo who go to mobility, coordinator of the project, mentor from UES and administrative staff who is in charge.

Four students from the University of East Sarajevo were registered on a web-based database created under this project, coordinated by the Department of Pedagogy at the Faculty of Philosophy. This is the first time that the University of East Sarajevo participates in the students with disabilities' exchange programme. Two students from the Faculty of Transport and Traffic Engineering Doboj – Vanja Grujić and Goran Ristić, a student from the Production and Management Faculty Trebinje – Milica Ijačić and a student of the Faculty of Philosophy Pale – Dejan Baković, are participating in this student mobility programme of the project. All students will do their internships in the fields related to their professional profiles and subjects they are majoring in for a period of two months from November 2017 to Jun 2018 at universities in Novi Sad, Belgrade, Kragujevac or Montenegro.



Participant of the round table discussed the implementation of the project main goals so far:

- a) To prepare and improve higher education institutions in order to support students with disabilities in their transition from faculty to workplace using and monitoring EU standards and policies;
- b) To link higher education institutions with a work environment appropriate to persons with disabilities;
- c) To assimilate transition opportunities and skills with the practices and policies of the European Union;
- d) To prepare employers for understanding the needs of people with disabilities in order to create and offer new jobs for these people.

The main target group for this project is a wide group of existing and future graduates with disabilities and employers from the private and public sectors. Since there is a need to strengthen the academic community so the concept of the school-to-work transition for these students is recognized and accepted, other target groups and potential partners of the university are: students with disabilities, university teachers and staff, existing university services, career centers and potential networks.

Objectives discussed at this dissemination activity can be achieved only with the support of higher education institutions that will enable students with disabilities to participate in the practice programs within the specific mobility program included in the Erasmus + credit mobility programme for students from higher education institutions.
